May 21st, 2010 (Paris) – Every Sofitel address will serve as a Music ambassador on June 21st 2010.

The Music Celebration, *Fête de la Musique*, was born in France in 1982, and has since taken place every June 21, the first day of summer in the northern hemisphere. It soon travelled abroad and has become a uniting international highlight. Europe

That evening, they will also enjoy a themed cocktail at the *IsarBar* including a selection of champagne-based creations and a buffet featuring French pastries.

Middle East and Africa

It will wake up to music by *Hiba*, a Moroccan artist, who will be performing live at the *Darkum Bar*. *Guitares Nomades*, a gypsy music band, will be playing at lunchtime, and customers will be able to enjoy a violin concert while they unwind around the pool that afternoon. The party will stretch into the evening at the *Lawrence Bar*, where two musicians will be playing France's best-known and longest-standing tunes.

Asia Pacific

Sofitel Legend Metropole Hanoi (Vietnam) – This hotel will be playing host to Andromeda Turre, an American jazz singer nominated for the 2008 Best Jazz Album Grammy award. Vietnamese music will be in the spotlight in the *Spices Garden* restaurant with a traditional folkloric band, and a French DJ will be livening up the well-known *Angelina* bar.

Sofitel Melbourne on Collins (Australia) – The *Sofi's Bar* and *Atrium Bar* will be celebrating Andalucía folklore with *Les Tsiganes*, a French trio and music-themed cocktails for customers.
